Navigation Instructions

Navigation: Navigating through the website can be done in three ways. First, there is a top menu on which all the pages can be accessed. Additionally, there are two navigation pages; Historical Context and Return to Burma. On each navigation page are two or more images with links beneath them to visit the subpages. In addition to clicking on the links, the subpages can also be accessed by clicking on the image. Finally, at the bottom of each page, it is possible to go from page to page.

Images: Images that are not on navigation pages can be enlarged by clicking on them. Image citations are either directly below the image or at the bottom of each page. There are no captions in the website. All images are referred to by their title only.

Endnotes: Throughout the website, quotes are cited using an endnote system. After each quote not on the homepage, there is an endnote link that goes to a page where all of the citations are listed in numerical order.
